We established our Patron Scheme in 2013 to enable us to continue delivering high quality arts projects during a time of ongoing changes in the arts sector and increasing cuts to public funding. The Patron support we have received so far has enabled us to work with over 1000 young people and perform for 700 audience members during the first stages of the Dancing in Museum project. Ammonite

£20 enables a child to experience a project in its fullest sense by participating in a workshop and watching a performance.



Trilobite

CURRENT PROJECT

The Dancing In Museums Project

The Dancing in Museums project consists of performances and creative dance workshops, and aims to provide a new way of thinking about museums and heritage sites, and the artefacts found within those sites, through dance activity. The Imagination Museum, the performance strand of the project, has been developed in collaboration with writer Anna Selby and composer Max Perryment. It is performed by three professional dancers who lead the audience around each museum, taking it in turns to bring to life a range of different artefacts through words and movement.

FUTURE PROJECTS

The Dancing In Caves Project

In 2014 we will begin researching a new strand to our Dancing in Museums project, which will be designed for performance in caves and other underground spaces.

For tens of thousands of years, people have visited caves in order to experience something out of the ordinary. Our new work will aim to continue this tradition of extraordinary experience, responding to the traces that have been left behind by our prehistoric ancestors, but also speaking about the world as it is now.

Our research will bring together artists (writer, composer, animation/projection artist, designer), experts from sites including Creswell Crags in Derbyshire, and we will also provide opportunities for young people to be involved in the Dancing in Caves project from its earliest stages.
